Our agreement at Copper's Mountain Goldendoodles with you, the Buyer, and we, the Seller, is to provide a healthy puppy with sound temperament. Both parent dogs have been extensively tested by veterinarian specialists and have been found to be free of risk of passing life-threatening or altering conditions to their offspring. Copper has OFA certifications for sound hips, eyes, heart, and DNA tests have been determined her to be free of carrier genes for development of problems in her puppies. The owners of this litter's sire, _______, have also provided their certifications for his health.

SELLER AGREES TO:

- 1. Provide a healthy puppy to the best of our knowledge and per the screenings and recommended veterinary care while in our care. We will disclose any concerns from the veterinarian, and will provide a copy of these records to the buyer in writing.
- 2. The puppy will be microchipped, which the buyer will register at their expense after choosing their permanent name.
- 3. Provide a 2-year health warranty against any life-inhibiting or hereditary conditions such as hip dysplasia, progressive retinal atrophy, or cardiomyopathy which may develop within this time period. This is unlikely due to the precautions we have taken with testing both parents. If some such condition were to be diagnosed, the seller will require written confirmation by a licensed veterinarian, including necropsy if the dog dies, at the buyer's expense.
- 4. If such a defect is diagnosed within the 2-year warranty period and would prevent the dog from living a normal life, the buyer will have an option to a replacement pup from a future litter. The Breeder will determine the replacement pup, and no guarantee is made for the timing of such replacement. The Breeder may opt to stop breeding Copper at any time in the future, and if this is

the case and no future litters are planned, the breeder will refund 50% of the purchase price of the dog, and will not require its return.

5. This warranty does not include viral illnesses, dental concerns, hernias, stress-related diarrhea, and other cosmetic concerns. Also excluded are parasitic conditions, cancer, endocrine or gastric disorders, or the ingestion of foreign objects, chemicals, or physical injury occurring after the puppy leaves our premises.

BUYER AGREES TO:

- 1. Pay the Seller a total sum of \$______ for the adoption of the puppy. This amount includes the deposit, and the final fee. This amount does not include any shipping or travel costs. Accidents or injuries can be expensive, the Seller recommends the Buyer obtain pet insurance for their future needs, by the time the puppy leaves our premises.
- 2. Have this puppy examined by their own licensed veterinarian WITHIN 72 HOURS of taking him/her home. Proof of this examination must be provided, if requested, to the Seller. If this is not done, the health warranty is void. All future health expenses will be assumed by the Buyer, once the puppy leaves our home.
- 3. If there is a health-related problem that cannot be rectified WITHIN 72 HOURS, the puppy may be returned to us, at the buyer's expense, and the purchase price of the puppy will be refunded. The Seller will require the proof of examination by a licensed vet with an explanation of the problem causing the need for this return option. This excludes any injury to the puppy resulting after the buyer is in possession, or any treatable parasite or infection noted by the veterinarian.
- 4. Register your puppy's microchip, information provided as above.
- 5. This puppy is being sold WITHOUT breeding rights. The intention for their life is for a companion and family pet. The puppy will be spayed/neutered when determined age-appropriate by the buyer's veterinarian. Proof of spay/neuter procedure must be provided to the Seller when the dog is one year of age or upon request.
- 6. Provide the best care for their puppy for the rest of their life. (For Goldendoodles this is likely 10-15 years.) This includes regular health check-ups, vaccinations, heart worm medication as recommended by the vet, housing the dog indoors, obedience training, regular grooming and maintenance, keeping to a healthy diet and weight, feeding quality dog food intended for active dogs in their appropriate life stage.
- 7. Give Copper's Mountain Goldendoodles first right of recovery of this puppy. Never place this puppy in a shelter, or to re-home them without first contacting the Seller. If the buyer is unable to care for their puppy, they must notify Copper's Mountain Goldendoodles about the change of circumstances, and the Seller will assist in finding another home.
- 8. Puppies' joints are still developing until after 1 year of age, so strenuous running, stair climbing, jumping, etc. should be avoided. Normal amounts of exercise are needed, and walking or playing in the yard is encouraged.
- 9. Allow use of pictures of the puppy on their website or other social media in any manner chosen by Copper's Mountain Goldendoodles.
- 10. The health warranty is valid only for the original purchaser of this puppy. In case of the untimely death of this puppy, necropsy report showing proof of a congenital defect will be provided, or the health warranty will be void.
